



RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY FOR THE HOGUE ISLAND BANK STABILIZATION – MR 1321.89 TO MR 1322.22

BE IT RESOLVED by the Water Resource Board of the Burleigh County Water Resource District, Burleigh County, North Dakota (the "Board"), as follows:

There having been proposed through action of this Board, pursuant to Chapter 61-16.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, the construction of a project, hereafter to be known and referred to as the HOGUE ISLAND BANK STABILIZATION – MR 1321.89 TO MR 1322.22 (the "Project"), which Project is proposed to be financed in whole or in part using funds raised through the collection of special assessments levied against lands and premises benefited by the Project's construction. Coordination with the North Dakota Department of Water Resources and the United States Army Corps of Engineer related to rehabilitating and restoring the Section 32 (Federal Revetments) located within the project limits, as well as permitting under their respective authorities will occur with project design and implemenation.

This Board having examined the proposed Project, hereby declares that further proceedings are warranted and that it is necessary to construct the Project, which has the following nature and purpose:

The proposed Hogue Island Bank Stabilization Project would include the following:

Restoration, rehabilitation, and replacement of the failed private bank stabilization revetment features located along the Missouri River extending from River Mile 1321.89 to River Mile 1322.1. This project includes only those properties designated after the Preliminary Engineering Report is completed and does not include the restoration/rehabilitation of the Section 32 federal revetments. The Section 32 revetements, along with any related easements, will be maintained or modified under the existing agreement with the North Dakota State Water Commission.

Michael H. Gunsch, PE, CFM, Houston Engineering, Inc., Bismarck, North Dakota, is hereby designated as the registered professional engineer to assist the Board with the design of the residential bank stabilization measures and is hereby directed to prepare a preliminary engineering report and preliminary plans for the proposed Project along with estimates of the total cost thereof, which estimates shall include acquisition of any necessary access rights-of-way and shall be in sufficient detail to allow the Board to determine the probable share of costs to be assessed to each benefitted parcel within the proposed assessment district.

PROJECT NO. 1-094(232)154, PCN 23595 MORTON COUNTY AND BURLEIGH COUNTY – I-94 MIDWAY AND GRANT MARSH BRIDGE ENGINEERING AND FEASIBILITY STUDY

The North Dakota Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration, is undertaking an Engineering and Feasibility Study (Study) for Interstate 94 (I-94) and other connecting-highway improvements from east of the Mandan Avenue interchange in Mandan, ND to east of the Tyler Parkway interchange in Bismarck, ND, including Interstate 194 (I-194) between I-94 and Memorial Highway. The study will consider replacement alternatives for the Grant Marsh Bridge.

Study elements will include an operational and geometric evaluation of the I-94 and I-194 highways and ramps to determine alternative future alignments of mainline Interstate and access-controlled highway connections, that coincide with replacement location alternatives for the Grant Marsh bridge. Study elements will include traffic analysis, environmental studies, river hydraulic studies, preliminary roadway and bridge design, and other analysis necessary to develop reasonable alternatives.

This Study will provide project-level analyses and early decisions that follow Federal Highway Administration guidance under the Planning and Environment Linkages (PEL) initiative. PEL is an integrated planning process that bridges the gap between long range/comprehensive planning and project level planning. The study transitions from long-range planning to the upcoming environmental review process by assessing existing conditions and developing alternatives. 

Brett: I have discussed with Michael and we feel that we could probably remove a couple of the items below and reduce the overall cost while still achieving the same objective. If we keep any disturbance confined to the channel then we don't have to worry nearly as much about restoration. I am going to take a stab at some adjustments here and see what we come up with.

Estimated stone 200 tons: \$10800

Trucking under load restriction: \$\frac{\$6100}{2} = \$3050 (No load restrictions - will wait until after they are lifted)

Reclaiming/removing some of the stone to get geotextile fabric in the proper place: \$1900 Existing fabric can stay where it is, and just add rock to fill the hole.

Grading the washout area for proper placement of geotextile fabric for project longevity: \$1200 This one we can review and consider the need for. I can see tuning it up a bit, but we will revisit now that the ice is gone.

Placement and carrying of the rip rap all the way to the wash out area: \$3600 The cost of getting the rock to the spot since we can't back trucks right up to it.

Topsoil for repair of the drainage ditch from equipment tracking: \$480- Probably not needed.

Geotextile fabric for underneath the stone: \$950 I think we keep this one and apply fabric to the eroded headwall where it's head cutting.

Straw blanket/netting for the swale/drain line repairing will be needed for restoration from gaining access also some cupping had started from the spring thaw: \$1100 We can evaluate the need for this once the work is done.

Restoring finish grade to the valley from equipment damage/placement of topsoil: \$1200 Agreed – remove tracking and smooth out work area.

Class 5 gravel for restoring the road/staging area: \$200 Agreed. Small cost to touch up the road.

Hydroseeding drainage ditch from damage done by carrying the Rip rap to the washout area: \$1750 \$1000 We can discuss this. Maybe the BCWRD would be okay with just running down the bottom with a drill. In this channel hydromulch may wash away. But seed drilled into the ground might stay put better when it rains. Yes, we know there is netting there so we will have to evaluate whether the drill can cut through the netting. But we will most likely want to seed the disturbed areas after the work is done so we will keep this number to cover seeding, however I have lowered it to reflect a scaled back seeding item.

Total project cost: \$29,280 \$22,000
